WHY A POLICY?

Policies and procedures are an essential part of any organization. Together, policies and procedures provide a roadmap for day-to-day operations. They ensure compliance with laws and regulations, give guidance for decision-making, and streamline internal processes.

Background checks

As staff or volunteer, you will be subject to a Michigan I-Chat, and Michigan Sex Offender Background check. This is a requirement to work with or around children.

- We will need a copy of your ID, it cannot be expired.
- Background agreement form/s need to be signed. (Located in volunteer and staff policy book).

*Field Trips / Events / Activities

Children who experience holistic development during their school years could grow up to become global citizens.
